

Consumption and Treatment Services (CTS) Closure Facts: Stay Sharp

On March 31, 2025, Guelph's Consumption and Treatment Services (CTS) will close.

The site will begin transitioning to a Homelessness and Addiction Recovery Treatment (HART) Hub. Starting April 1, 2025, the site will no longer offer supervised consumption services.

Stay Sharp will not be part of the HART Hub.

A needle exchange cannot be part of the HART Hub. However, the HART Hub staff will be able to refer to harm reduction services, including Stay Sharp.

Stay Sharp will stay open.

Stay Sharp has different funding than CTS. We are working on creating easy referral pathways to Stay Sharp from the HART Hub.

Stay Sharp is dedicated to reducing the transmission of blood-borne infections such as HIV and HCV, and minimizing risks associated with substance use.

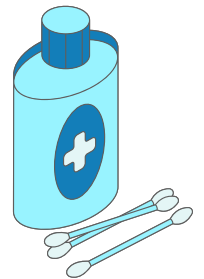
Services at Stay Sharp

Accessible harm reduction services, including confidential counseling, personalized support, and referrals

Supplies for safer drug use like sterile needles, water, alcohol swabs, and more

Needle exchange services and safe sharps disposal

Education on safer injection and inhalation techniques, and naloxone to reverse opioid overdoses
